Graduating Seniors, Belmont University Students, and Parents,

The student ministry of Brentwood Baptist has the honor annually of presenting college scholarships to members of our church who are attending Belmont University. There are two sources for these scholarships: 1) one is in honor of our Senior Pastor Emeritus Bill Wilson, and 2) the remainder from a foundation set up by members in the past decade.

Students need only to apply once each year and must meet the following criteria:

- Must be a member of Brentwood Baptist Church.
- Must be enrolled as a full-time student, undergraduate (12 hours minimum) at Belmont University for the coming academic year.
- Must complete the scholarship application in full and return to the student ministry office no later than **the end of the day on Sunday, February 14.**
- Must have two (2) letters of recommendation received in the student ministry office no later than **Sunday, February 14.**

Please note: children of faculty or staff of Belmont, University College Students, and Graduate Students are not eligible for this scholarship. All endowed scholarships are for full-time, undergraduate, “traditional” students.

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of all eligibility criteria. The total amount awarded varies according to the amount of interest accrued, so it varies from year to year. All eligible applications will receive at least some amount. Awards are not renewable, but students may reapply to the program each year they meet eligibility requirements. The Student Ministry office will notify scholarship recipients at the home address provided by **Tuesday, March 16.**

Note that the scholarships awarded are annual and Belmont usually applies half of the amount to each semester of an academic year. The application is attached. Please contact the Student Ministry office with any questions at 324.6126.
